## **ENZOOTIC BOVINE LEUCOSIS (EBL) & JOHNE'S DISEASE**

Please note the following requirements for exhibitors in relation to EBL & John's Disease for the Show.

All Interstate Exhibits: One negative blood test for both EBL & John's disease to be conducted within 30 days prior to the Show.

South Australian Exhibits: A declaration that both diseases are not known to exist on the property within the previous five (5) years. Interstate cattle on a South Australian property for less than one year must be tested negative to both diseases within 30 days prior to the show.
