Special Notes

- 1. All exhibits to be the work of the exhibitor, who must also be the owner, and exhibits must not have previously won a first prize at Balaklava Show.**
2. General access to the pavilion by exhibitors is not permitted on judging day.
3. In this section, where all small articles and where three or more articles are entered in one class, they must be mounted on cardboard by exhibitor before bringing to the show.
- 4. All exhibits to be unwashed and completed in the last 12 months.**
- 5. Judging commences at 9am on Thursday 20th September for all classes.**
- 6. Stewards reserve the right to place articles in correct class if not entered correctly**
7. All exhibits must be in the hands of the Secretary by **Wed 19th Sept** at 4.00pm, not prior to this date unless organised with the Secretary.
- 8. Place exhibits in a box or carton of suitable size, securely fastened and showing name and address of exhibitor, with class ticket attached.**
9. Please notify Convenor or Secretary if articles are not entered.
- 10. Pavilion will be closed at 4:00pm and reopen at 4:30pm for collection of items. No exhibits to be removed from Pavilion before this time..** Your copy of your entry form **MUST BE PRESENTED** when collecting articles from the Pavilion.
- 11. Prize money will be paid from 4.00pm from the Convenor in the Pavilion.**
12. All entries must be collected on the day no later than 5.00pm unless prior arrangements made with the Convenor. If not collected it will be up to the discretion of the Convenor to discard.
13. A novice in any section would be someone who has just started to learn and enjoy their craft, like knitting or quilting, and this may be their first time entering in the show.
